Interment will be held privately, by family.

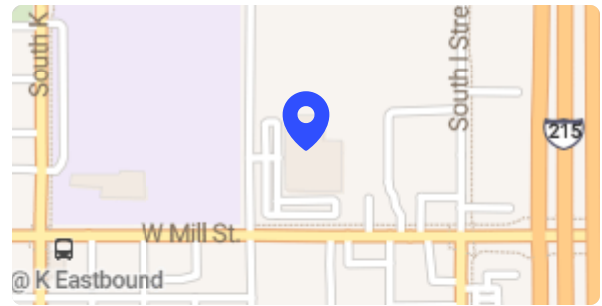

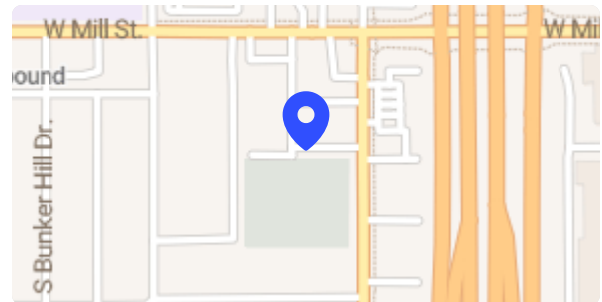

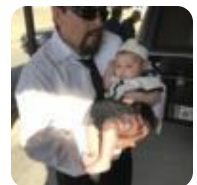
